### Handmade Musical Instruments of Tyrol to Music fair Frankfurt

Telfs, March, 2016 - The musical instruments of Roderick´s Dubious Instruments ☆ by the tyrolean Roderick O. Pischl from Telfs, will be exhibited in the most important music fair in Europe. The music fair takes place in Frankfurt from 7th to 10th April, 2016 and is the leading international trade fair for music, with more than thousand exhibitors from over 50 countries and more than 65,000 visitors from 120 countries (in the edition 2015).

In the music fair (Hall 8.0, booth J 75) the tyrolean instrument maker Roderick of Roderick´s Dubious Instruments ☆ is presenting his 100% handmade musical instruments made of fine woods: Monochords and Kotamos, Instruments which are suitable for meditation and relaxation, but also the innovative BodyTAMpure © ( body Monochord) and the foldable Soundbed used for body massage and therapy through sound.

Since approximately 2000 Roderick O. Pischl is fascinated by homemade musical instruments, and in his workshop in Telfs (Austria), he builds not only monochord, KoTaMo and body monochord, but also guitar rarities and djembes. And he also offers DIY workshops, in which everybody can build his own instruments, that have already attracted the interest of an international audience.
